Automated Milking Systems (Robotic Milkers) – What We Know, Still Don't Know and Have Learned Along the Way –

WORKSHOP SUMMARY: This short course on Automated Milk Systems (AMS or *Robotics*) was developed by dairy professionals with regulatory, engineering and AMS milk quality backgrounds. The course will provide perspectives on building a new barn or retrofitting an existing facility with cow flow for AMS in mind; the importance of keeping in constant contact with your milk inspector and/or regulatory personnel during the install phase; and how to manage the AMS for efficiencies and quality starting from day one. DPC GL # 109, AUTOMATIC MILKING SYSTEMS; QUESTIONS DAIRYMEN NEED TO ASK will also be discussed. The course includes a booklet and flash drive (digital copies) of all presentation materials, including DPC GL# 109, lunch, and breaks.
